

Do you have an ITIN*?

ALERT: YOUR ITIN MAY EXPIRE ON JANUARY 1, 2017

- * ITINs with the middle digits **78** or **79** (i.e. 9XX-**78**-XXXX) will expire on January 1, 2017.
- * ITINs that have not been used on a tax return in the last three years (2013, 2014, or 2015) will expire on January 1, 2017.

If you or someone on your tax return (i.e. spouse, dependent) has an ITIN that is expiring, **that ITIN should be renewed before you file your return.**

DON'T WAIT – TAKE ACTION TODAY

Failure to renew expiring ITINs before filing your 2016 tax return will result in delayed refunds and the disallowance of federal tax credits, which may reduce your tax refund amount or increase the amount you may owe the federal government.
